We have so many talented people in Ideford and surrounding areas that we thought it would be great to shout about it and bring all of them together for a fantastic shopping event.

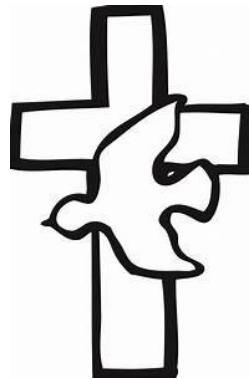
There will be local artists, beauty specialists, photography, sweet treats; all displaying their products for you to browse and treat yourself or a friend/family member.
