In line with the new contract the following items **will not** be accepted through the Rural Skip service and will instead need to be taken to one of the Devon County Council run household waste and recycling centres (when charges may apply). The nearest centre is on Brunel Industrial Estate, Newton Abbot:

Dead pets and animals	Food waste	Garden waste
Demolition & construction waste	Plastic window or door frames (with or without glass)	Bath or shower tray (plastic, fibreglass or composite)
Plastic pipes/guttering/fascia etc.	Soil & rubble including tiles & sanitary ware	Shower screen (glass or plastic)
Insulation materials	Roofing felt	Trade waste
Oils & other liquid wastes including household chemicals	Hazardous waste including fluorescent tubes	Toxic waste

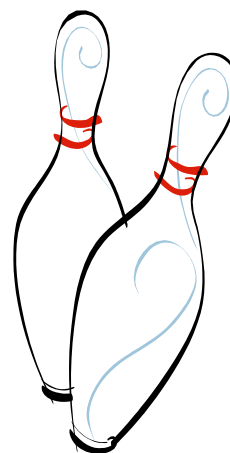
