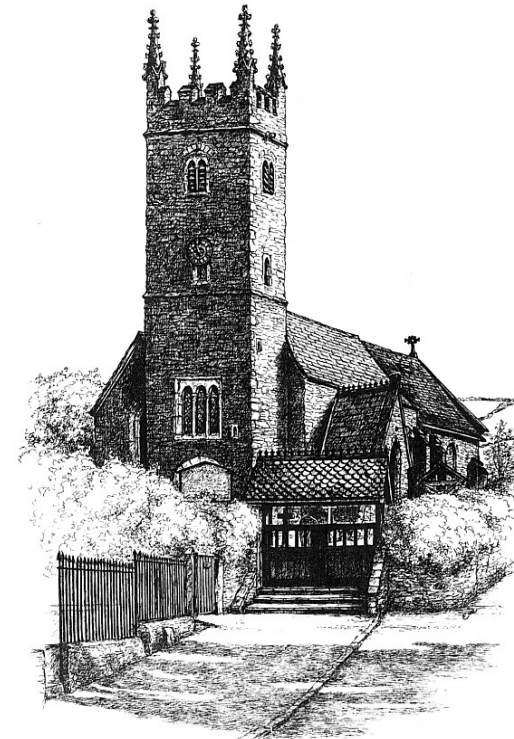

## 200 Years of St Michael's Church, Teignmouth and the RNLI

This has been a big year for the RNLI they have been celebrating their 200 year anniversary. All over the country there have been all kinds of events starting with a big service in Westminster Abbey. In Teignmouth and Shaldon the wonderful local volunteers have been marking this time in all sorts of ways fundraising and getting involved as they support our local crews. Facing the perils of the sea requires strong values as crew members rely on one another to live out the RNLI motto "with courage nothing is impossible". The RNLI have 4 values which guide their team's formation: trustworthy, courageous, selfless and dependable.

St Michael's Church is also celebrating 200 years of its present incarnation (there was a medieval church which disappeared under the new building). Its size reflects the confidence and prosperity of the town growing up around it and would have been packed with many paying a pew rental (unthinkable now!).

Jesus loved a party just look at the wedding at Cana and he wasn't backward in coming forward when the 5000 needed to be fed. So we thought let's celebrate our 200 years together with a big concert.

ON Sat. 28th September at 7pm in St Michael's Church a Gala Prom Concert. Featuring Back Beach Boyz, Teignmouth Sings, Teignmouth Youth Choir and St Michael's Singers. The second half will have a proms feel to it and will include an appearance of Dame Carolina Greendale from Convent Garden to lead traditional prom songs. 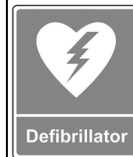

076/24	<b>WELCOME AND APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE:</b> The Chair opened the meeting at 7pm and welcomed everyone. Apologies were received from Cllr Gearon and PCSO Bunce
077/24	<b>MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING:</b> It was agreed by all to accept the minutes of the meeting of the 13th June 2024 as a true and accurate record.
078/24	<b>078/24 DECLARATION OF INTERESTS:</b> None.
079/24	<b>PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:</b> The owner from Rixafer bungalow explained why there is an application to remove a condition in planning number 24/00705/FUL, he indicated it had a certificate of lawfulness at the outset. TDC planning indicated they would grant planning permission if the certificate of lawfulness was removed. He went on to explain they have a son with autism and they were planning on using the mobile home for him in the long run. A discussion took place between councillors, who pointed out that family situations are not included with planning but in this case it could be considered. DCC Peart had a discussion with the owners after the meeting to see if there was anything he could do.
080/24	<b>REPORTS:</b> Cllr R Peart (DCC) Due to the elections there is no report. He has been getting up to date with the parish councils since the new government was elected and has met with Phil Shears, he mentioned the issue about the land that Ideford wants to clarify who owns it. There was no report from Cllr Gearon due to illness.
081/24	<b>PARISH MATTERS:</b> <b>081.1</b> Volunteer awards - Cllr Batting requested this be moved to the part 2, proposed by Cllr Batting and Cllr C Hill seconded it. <b>081.2</b> Roads, Highway, Updates:- Waterworks on Olchard Lane, the chair indicated they hope to finish it on schedule. Olchard lane - they have patched a few holes. But full repair still waiting for a date. The question was raised about lorries coming through the village, accidents on A380 will result in this. Signage is dependent on certain conditions and it doesn't appear that signage will be applicable. Parking - we are still waiting for the lines to be painted.





## SUSTAINABLE IDEFORD A- Z.

### S is for SEASIDE

We are only a few miles from the Seaside and many Ideford villagers enjoy a trip to the beach. These days we have to make sure our trip to the coast is not blighted by pollution.

Always be extra cautious after spells of heavy rainfall when surface water is washed into our rivers and seas. This can contain pollution from urban and agricultural run-off, as well as leakage from septic tanks.

Download the Safer Seas & Rivers Service app which alerts users in real time when untreated sewage is discharged into the sea or when water quality is affected by extreme weather and it covers 200 locations across the UK. Check out our local beaches Teignmouth and Holcombe and Teignmouth Town. Alternatively check the Environment Agency's website Swimfo which allows you to check water quality at more than 400 locations.

Signs at the beach should also alert you if the sea is potentially unsafe for swimming. Wait a minimum of 48 hours before entering the water after a sewage spill or a period of heavy rainfall.

If litter on the beach gets you down try a Beach Litter Pick either on your own or with a group. Carry gardening gloves and if you don't think you'll come across a bin, bring a bag with you. There are bags for rubbish available by Teignmouth Pier provided for impromptu 2 minute clean ups. Please Stay safe by staying away from needles and not picking up anything with human waste (like nappies), electrical items, or holding any potentially dangerous chemicals. If you're not sure what it is, don't pick it up.

Take extra care when picking up anything sharp and report anything you think might be dangerous, or any dumped electrical items or paint to the local council or landowner. If you come across a fly-tipping site, or a dead animal, report it.

If possible, separate what you've collected that can be recycled. Safety proof anything you find that could be a danger to wildlife if it ends up in the wrong place further down the line such as sections of fishing net or fishing line. Plastic particles once in the sea can be mistaken for prey by sea creatures leading to choking and blocking the airways and stomach.

Always make sure you wash your hands properly after picking litter. Enjoy our beautiful beaches and help to keep them that way
